Time and Place of Opening Bids

Notice is hereby given that the Village of Wilmette, Illinois, acting through the Department of Engineering, will receive sealed bid proposals at the Wilmette Village Hall, 1200 Wilmette Avenue, Wilmette, Illinois until **Tuesday, December 13, 2011 at 11:00AM., CST**, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read.

Description of Project

The Project generally consists of stone and brick masonry repairs and restoration, tuck-pointing and cleaning of exterior and interior masonry at the Wilmette Water Plant. The work also includes the addition of new metal flashing and weep holes, repair or replacement of steel lintels, caulking and the application of water-repellant.

Bid Security

All bid proposals must be accompanied by a bid deposit in the form of cash, certified check, cashier's check, bank draft or bid bond payable to the Village of Wilmette equal to ten (10%) percent of the amount of the bid.

Performance and Payment Bonds

The successful Bidder will be required to furnish Performance and Payment Bonds for one hundred (100%) percent of the contract sum. Said Bonds shall be in a form acceptable to the Village and must be deposited with the Village at the time of execution of the Contract.

Contract Award and Rejection of Bids

The Village reserves the right to defer the award of the contract for a period not to exceed thirty (30) calendar days after the date bids are received and to accept or reject any or all proposals or any parts thereof, to waive technicalities, to waive any irregularities or informalities in bid procedures and to award the contract in a manner best serving the interest of the Village.
