

ORDINANCE NO. 2011-O-24

**AN ORDINANCE MAKING AN AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 5
OF THE VILLAGE CODE**

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees (collectively “Village Board”) of the Village of Wilmette, Cook County, Illinois (“Village”), find that the Village is a home rule municipal corporation as provided in Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois and, pursuant to said constitutional authority, may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs for the protection of the public health, safety, morals and welfare;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES of the Village of Wilmette, Cook County, Illinois:

SECTION 1: The Wilmette Village Code, 1993, as amended, is further amended in Chapter 5, “Regulation of Certain Commercial and Quasi-Commercial Activities” by amending Subsection 5-2.6.4.(j) in the manner and form shown below with additions being underlined and deletions being shown in strikethrough text, so that said Subsection shall hereafter provide as follows:

(j) No furnishings and obstructions shall be permitted on the public sidewalk or right-of-way from November 1 each year through and including ~~April 30~~ March 31 of the succeeding year.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as required by law.
