

Acceptable Recycling Materials:

Aerosol cans (must be empty)

Aluminum and tin food cans and foil, rinsed clean

Aseptic packaging (juice boxes)

Boxes and cartons

Brown paper bags

Chipboard/paperboard (includes: brown or gray box board or paperboard, cereal boxes, shoe boxes, paper towel cores, flattened, 2' by 2' size max)

Corrugated cardboard (flattened, 2' by 2' size max)

Formed aluminum containers and wraps

Frozen food packaging

Gable top containers (milk and juice cartons)

Glass bottles & jars (brown, green, and clear), rinsed clean

Magazines, Catalogs, and Telephone Books

Mixed paper and junk mail, glossy and non-glossy (includes: stationary, notebook paper, post-it-notes, computer paper, typing paper, flyers, greeting cards, file folders and all envelopes, with and without windows)

Newspaper (including all inserts and glossies)

Plastic containers (includes: colored or cloudy white #2-HDPE milk, juice and/or water bottles, jars and jugs)

Plastic containers in categories #1 through #7; including, #1-PETE, #2-HDPE, #3-PVC or Vinyl, #4-LDPE, #5-PP, #6-PS* (*Styrofoam cups and clamshell carry-out food containers only), and #7-mixed resins (all plastics must be stamped with a number to be accepted)

#4-LDPE and #2-HDPE soft plastic six (6) and twelve (12) pack rings

Steel cans

Steel paint cans and lids (clean and empty only)

Wet strength carrier stock (includes: paper board used for refrigerated and frozen food items)

*Used motor oil and car batteries will no longer be accepted
