

ComEd – 2012 Tree Pruning Scheduled (selected areas)

ComEd has notified the Village of upcoming vegetation management activities (tree pruning) to occur along distribution circuits. Vegetation management is key component of ComEd's maintenance program to ensure electrical reliability, as vegetation contact with utility lines and infrastructure is a leading cause of outages.

- Work is scheduled for the following areas: South of Glenview Road, between Crawford Ave and Hibbard Rd; and North of Glenview Road to Wilmette Ave., between Locust and Hunter Roads ([please see attached map](#)).
- All affected residences will receive a [notification postcard](#) from ComEd.
- Tree pruning is scheduled to take place between the months of January and February.
- Work will be conducted by qualified line-clearance workers, contracted by ComEd.
- All wood debris that can be processed through a brush chipper will be chipped and hauled away; any larger material (e.g. logs) will be cut into manageable size pieces and left on the property. *Please note- ComEd will not haul away larger material.
