

- Install curb extension on west side of Sheridan Road (3-4 feet) to improve sight lines to/from the north
- Install pedestrian warning sign (W11-2) and "AHEAD" placard (W16-9P) facing southbound at 250 feet north of the crosswalk
- Install pedestrian warning signs (W11-2) and "∠" placards (W16-7P) facing northbound and southbound at each end of the crosswalk
- Modify striping for southbound entry to bike lane
- Crosswalk (brick)
- Pedestrian Ramp
- Pedestrian Warning / Crosswalk Sign





Consider potential material change, consistent with corridor


Crosswalk (existing)



- A Install new crosswalk with differentiating color/material, consistent with other crosswalks on Sheridan Road
- B Install pedestrian warning signs (W11-2) and "∠" placards (W16-7P) facing northbound and southbound at each end of the crosswalk
- Crosswalk (brick)
- Pedestrian Warning / Crosswalk Sign




- A Maintain existing crosswalk and Pedestrian Crosswalk Sign (R1-6a) on-street on the south side of the southern crosswalk to limit potential impacts by turning vehicles
- Brick repairs to the southern crosswalk (current asphalt patches)
- ____ Crosswalk (existing)




- Replace striped crosswalk in brick intersection with a concrete crosswalk and continental striping
- Realign the crosswalk across Michigan
 Avenue to eliminate the bend, leading
 directly to the pedestrian ramp. The ramp
 on the southeast corner may require
 reconstruction/expansion
- Repair brick intersection
- Install wayfinding signs orienting pedestrians/cyclists to the Sheridan Road underpass along the Channel
- Crosswalk (brick)
- Crosswalk (concrete with continental striping)
- Pedestrian Ramp
- Pedestrian Warning / Crosswalk Sign
- Wayfinding Sign

- Relocate crosswalk to east end of brick intersection with a median refuge. Use differentiating color/materials and/or continental stripe markings
- **B** Remove sidewalk / pedestrian ramp
- Crosswalk (concrete with pattern and parallel striping)

- Pedestrian Ramp
- Pedestrian Warning / Crosswalk Sign
- Sidewalk Removal
