## Project Background

The Neighborhood Storage Project consists of new underground stormwater storage facilities at several parks on the west side of the Village that will work together with new larger diameter storm sewers on several Village streets to reduce overland flooding. It is estimated that the project will be constructed in 4 phases over the next 3 years.

The Village has contracted with Berger Excavating Contractors (Wauconda, IL) to complete Phase 1 Improvements. Phase 1 includes work related to the Community Playfield underground storage vault and surrounding neighborhood storm sewer installations to be constructed in 2020. Additional optimized storm sewers will be completed on Hunter Rd and Washington Ave in the Summer of 2021.

The areas to be completed during Phase 1:

#### Spring/Summer 2020

- Wilshire Dr (N of Glenview Rd to Wilmette Ave)
- Wilmette Ave (Wilshire Dr to Meadow Dr)
- Meadow Dr (Wilmette Ave to N Meadow Dr)

#### Summer 2020

- Highcrest Middle School
- Community Playfield

#### Summer 2021

- Hunter Rd (Illinois Rd to Birchwood Ave)
- Washington Ave (Hunter Rd to Pinecrest Ln)

## FAQs

### When is construction scheduled to begin?

#### Wilshire Rd, Wilmette Ave, Meadow Dr

April 6, 2020 - July 2020 (Wilmette, Meadow)

August 2020- September 2020 (Wilshire)

#### Highcrest Sewer, Illinois Rd / Hunter Rd Intersection

June 19, 2020 - August 16, 2020

#### Hunter Rd, Washington Avenue

Summer 2021

### What are the construction work hours?

The Contractor is allowed to work from 7AM-7PM, Monday-Friday and on Saturdays 9AM-6PM; no work is anticipated on Sundays within the roadway.

### Will I have access to my driveway during construction?

Driveway access will be restricted only when work is being performed at your driveway. The Contractor will restore access to all driveways at the end of each day, excluding days when new concrete is placed at your driveway. (This includes driveway pavement, curb/gutter, and sidewalk.) You will be informed in advance of any necessary closure. Please notify one of the contacts listed on this flyer if you have specific access requirements or concerns.

### Where can I park my car during construction?

When access to your driveway or street is limited, you may park on adjacent side streets. The Wilmette Police Department has been notified of project limits and should not ticket vehicles temporarily impacted by construction. (You must follow existing street signs on adjacent streets, including permanent No Parking restrictions.)

### Will my driveway be replaced during construction?

Not all driveway aprons are scheduled to be replaced. In some cases, partial driveway aprons will be replaced to match new curb and gutter. The planned limits for driveway replacement will be painted at the start of each stage for impacted areas.

### How will traffic be impacted during construction?

During construction on Wilshire and Wilmette, the road will be closed to thru traffic, but residents will have access. Meadow will always remain open to traffic, but residents may experience construction traffic delays. Wilmette Avenue traffic will be detoured to Glenview Road during this stage. During Highcrest Middle School and Community Playfield vault construction, Hunter and Illinois Road will be closed for 6-8 weeks. Traffic will be detoured to Ridge Road from both Lake Avenue and Wilmette Avenue during this stage.

### Will construction impact mail delivery or garbage pickup?

No. The USPS will be notified prior to the start of work, and normal delivery will continue. Coordination with Advanced Disposal will occur throughout the project. Your scheduled weekly pickup should remain the same. Please have garbage ready for pickup by 7AM; Advanced Disposal may request early pickup in construction areas to prevent delays.

### What happens if I have a sprinkler system or special landscaping feature within the parkway?

Please contact the Construction Project Manager if you have a sprinkler system or special landscaping feature in the parkway or near the public sidewalk. We ask that residents with underground sprinkler systems locate these features before construction so that the Contractor is aware of your system before digging in your area.

### Will my water be shut off?

A new water main will be installed on Wilshire Dr. In order to switch over service to a new water main there will be temporary water shut downs. These scheduled shut downs will be limited to 6 hours. All residents will be notified 48 hours prior to the scheduled shut downs.
