






Trail south of project




Trail north of project





Phase	Percentage of Cost	Total Cost
Phase I Study	Cook County 50% Villages 50%	\$288,000
Phase II Design	Federal Sources 80%* Villages 20%	\$300,000
Land Acquisition	Federal Sources 80%* Villages 20%	\$297,000
Construction	Federal Sources 80%* Villages 20%	\$3,000,000
Construction Engineering	Federal Sources 80%* Villages 20%	\$300,000
