I. CALL TO ORDER

Commissioner Ehlman called the meeting to order at 3:03 p.m. Board members Ehlman, Davidson and Krueger were present.

II. PUBLIC COMMENT

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Commissioner Davidson moved to approve minutes of the April 6, 2021 meeting. Commissioner Krueger seconded the motion. No further discussion occurred on the motion. Voting yes: Commissioners Ehlman, Davidson and Krueger. Voting no: none. **The motion carried.**

VI. SET MINIMUM PASSING SCORE FOR THE POLICE WRITTEN AND WRITTEN SUBJECTIVE EXAMINATION

Ms. Cease stated that per the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners Rules and Regulations a minimum passing score for the written examination must be set.

Commissioner Davidson moved to set the minimum passing score for the Police Written and Written Subjective examination at 70. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Krueger.
