



# Fluorescent Light Bulb Recycling Program



## RESIDENTS – please adhere to the following GUIDELINES:

- This program is for spent household Compact Fluorescent Light Bulbs (CFLs) and 4' or 8' fluorescent light tubes (in specified communities).
- DO NOT drop-off Incandescent Light Bulbs – the old fashion 60 – 75 – 100 Watt bulbs that get hot to the touch. These light bulbs do not contain mercury or any other hazardous materials and can be thrown away in the garbage can
- Schools, institutions and businesses must contact a fluorescent light bulb recycler for their materials – see SWANCC's Green Pages Reuse and Recycling Directory at [swancc.org](http://swancc.org) for vendors.

### ACCEPTABLE BULBS:

- Compact Fluorescent Bulbs and Tubes



### NON-ACCEPTABLE BULBS:

- Incandescent bulbs
- Halogen bulbs
