

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-O-64

AN ORDINANCE DECREASING THE NUMBER OF CLASS C AND CLASS M LIQUOR LICENSES AND INCREASING CLASS C-B LIQUOR LICENSES (JP MCCARTHY'S AND GUSTO RISTORANTE)

WHEREAS, the Village of Wilmette, Cook County, Illinois (“Village”), is a home rule municipal corporation as provided in Article VII, Section 6 of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois and, pursuant to said constitutional authority, may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs for the protection of the public health, safety, morals and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Village’s Local Liquor Licenses are issued to specific individuals or entities as the case may be, and are not transferrable; and

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees (collectively “Village Board”) finds that Gusto of Wilmette, LLC., d/b/a/ Gusto Ristorante (“Gusto Ristorante”) had previously applied for and been granted a Class M Liquor License; and that Gusto Ristorante has decided to not renew their Class M liquor license as the business will be permanently closed; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board further finds that Klavdia, Inc., d/b/a JP McCarthy’s (“JP McCarthy’s”) had previously applied for and been granted a Class C Liquor License; and

WHEREAS, JP McCarthy’s has modified their business plan to sell only beer and wine and no longer sell any other alcoholic liquors and as such has applied for a Class C-B Liquor License which would authorize the retail sale of beer and wine only by restaurants with a bar that is:

- a. no longer than 15 feet,
- b. seats no more than 8 patrons at a time, and
- c. is located in the principal room where meals are served; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board sees fit to increase the number of authorized Class C-B Liquor Licenses and decrease the number of Class C and Class M Liquor Licenses as set forth herein; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES of the Village of Wilmette, Cook County, Illinois:

SECTION 1: The above recitals are incorporated in this ordinance as if fully set forth.

SECTION 2: The Wilmette Village Code, as amended, is further amended in Chapter 10, Liquor Control, Article I, In General, Section 10-11, "Number of Licenses," by deleting the text of said Section 10-11 in the manner shown in strikethrough type below and inserting such new text in the manner shown in underlined bold type below, so that said Section 10-11 shall hereafter provide as follows:

Sec. 10-11 NUMBER OF LICENSES.

The following shall be the number of licenses to be issued in each Class:

On and after March 14, 1995, no further Class G Licenses shall issue and the Class G License shall be eliminated upon the expiration without renewal, or the revocation of, or the surrender of the last Class G License held prior to March 14, 1995.


