The Wilmette Police Department is accredited by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies (CALEA). The department has 45 sworn officers, 23 civilian employees and excellent facilities and equipment. The Wilmette Police provide a full range of law enforcement services, responding to between 15,000 and 20,000 calls each year.

Eligibility Requirements

- Hold a Bachelor's degree in any discipline and provide proof by July 1, 2016.
- Possess a valid driver's license;
- Be 21 years of age, but under 35 years of age by the application deadline. May 2, 2016;
- Submit proof that they have passed the Illinois POWER test within the past year.
- The ability to perform the essential functions of the position of Police Officer with or without reasonable accommodation;

Applications

All applications and required documents must be submitted to IO Solutions by **4:00 p.m. May 2, 2016** with the exception of Official transcripts indicating attainment of a Bachelor's degree. Spring graduates have until July 1st to submit your transcripts. You are wholly responsible for ensuring the completeness and accuracy of your application.

Testing Process

The candidate orientation and written exam will be conducted on **Saturday, June 4, 2016.** at Loyola Academy, 1100 Laramie Avenue, Wilmette, IL 60091. You are required to arrive at the testing location **no later than 8:30 a.m. with photo identification (valid driver's license or State ID)** to sign-in. The mandatory orientation will begin promptly at 8:30 AM and testing will immediately follow; NO LATE ADMITTANCE. Candidates will be eligible to participate in the written exam ONLY IF they have submitted the application and required documents by May 2, 2016.
