Residential Burglaries

On Sunday, March 17th at 4:53 PM, unknown offenders burglarized a residence in the 1100 block of Seneca Rd. The homeowners related that they left their home at 4:40 PM and noticed an unfamiliar car parked on Seneca. At 4:53 PM, Wilmette Police responded to a burglar alarm and upon arrival found a door had been pried and the home had been burglarized. It appears that jewelry was taken.

On Saturday, March 9th between 1:00 PM and 8:40 PM, unknown offenders burglarized the residence in the 600 block of Lacrosse Ave by forcing a side door. The offenders searched multiple rooms and took cash and a watch.

Unlocked Auto Burglaries

Between 6:30 PM on Thursday, March 14th and 2:21 AM on Friday, March 15th, unknown offender(s) entered an unlocked vehicle that was parked on the street in the 1400 block of Gregory Ave. The offender(s) took a women's winter coat, a wallet, a bag of makeup and sunglasses.

During the early morning hours of Monday, March 11th, unknown offenders burglarized four unlocked vehicles that were parked in the 1600 block of Wilmette Ave; the 1500 block of Lake Ave and the 1600 block of Elmwood Ave.

- ***People walking in an alley or sidewalk slowly and looking into homes, garages and backyards.***
- ***A vehicle slowly and repeatedly driving through the neighborhood.***
