The Wilmette Police Department wants to share with residents the opportunity to register for [Smart911](#), which allows you to create a safety profile that will provide

important information to first responders in an emergency. [Smart911](#) is a free opt-in service, and you can provide as much or as little information as you would like. When anyone in your household dials 911 from a landline or cell phone connected to your safety profile, all the information is immediately displayed to the emergency dispatcher.
