Possession Stolen Motor Vehicle Arrest

On March 5, 2020 Wilmette Police Detectives arrested an 18-year-old offender from Chicago for his involvement in a residential burglary and auto theft on February 4, 2020. During this incident, offenders entered an unlocked vehicle parked in the driveway in the 1000 block of Seminole Road, Wilmette. The offenders used a garage door opener found in one vehicle to open the attached garage. Offenders entered the garage and additional vehicles parked inside. The offenders stole one vehicle with the keys left inside. The stolen vehicle was recovered in a south suburb later that same day.

The offender was positively linked to the stolen vehicle and identified through video surveillance. The offender, who at the time of the offense was a juvenile, is being petitioned as a juvenile.

The offender has over 20 prior arrests for numerous offenses including, criminal trespass to vehicles, unlawful use of a weapon, armed robbery, burglary and 7 priors for possession of stolen motor vehicle.
