- All weights shall be rounded up to the next highest 1,000 lb.
- Low slung trucks shall use the rail crossing at Wilmette Ave and shall **avoid the rail crossings at Linden Ave, Oakwood Ave and Lake Ave.**
- This permit does not give authority to move vehicle across bridges or structures that are posted as having a lower weight limit than the permitted per the permit.
- Once approved, this permit must be carried in the vehicle at all times and must be available for inspection by Police Department Officials.
- In order to change a previously approved route, the Permittee must contact the Wilmette Police Department at 847.256.1200 to revise the permit to starting the move.
- Vehicles in excess of 18' Wide, 16' High, 135' Long require escort as per the village ordinance.

Section 14-140 Overweight and Oversized Permits

Permit fee schedules.

The village with respect to streets under its jurisdiction shall collect a fee as shown herein from applicants for the issuance of a permit to operate or move a vehicle or combination of vehicles, and/or loads, which fit the categories shown. Any axle or gross weight greater than the maximum weights set forth in the fee schedule are subject to special assessment and investigation to determine appropriate fees.

Fee schedule.

- a. The fee schedule for single vehicles shall be as follows:

(g) Violations, penalties.

(1) It shall be unlawful for any person to violate any of the requirements set forth in this section. Furthermore, it shall be unlawful for any person issued a permit under this section, or any employee or agent of such person, to violate any of the terms or conditions of the permit. The penalty for any such violation shall be a fine in an amount not less than \$250.00 and not more than \$750.00. Penalties for any violation of this section shall be in addition to any penalties imposed for the violation of any other section of this chapter.

(2) Any person, firm, business, or corporation that owns and operates the transporting vehicle or that operates the vehicle under a bona fide lease agreement who violates any of the provisions of this section, may avoid prosecution for violating any of this section by surrendering the citation or other notice of violation and paying to the Police Department within ten days from the date appearing on said violation notice, the sum of \$250.00. Any person making such payment shall receive a receipt therefor from the Police Department.
